# Bye Bye Birdie!

Transport yourself back to the 1950's with ACT'ssummer production of Bye, Bye Birdie. Over 104 children from 17 Boston area communities are involved in the production, and will bring the fifties alive in this musical comedy Friday, July 29th through Saturday, August 6th at the newly renovated Regent Theater, 7 Medford Street, Arlington.

This year's production is artfully led by Colleen Rua, director of ACT's wildly successful productions of The Adventures of Tom Sawyer (2004) and Oliver! (2003). Colleen says that although Bye Bye Birdie is a comedy, "the characters struggle with the complexity of parent--child relationships, war, love, and rapidly changing times. On the surface, it's all sweetness and light, but there's much more to it underneath."

## **ACT's Fall Workshop Schedule**

#### JR Discovery Theatre for the Younger Artist

Instructor: Jacqueline Rossi Ages: 4-6

**Saturdays**, 9:30 AM to 10:15 Session I: Sept10th- Oct 1st

Cost: \$60

Through theatrical play, music, yoga and movement, children learn to sing in different languages, act out musical stories, practice simple yoga moves, work collaboratively with each other and, most importantly, have fun.

#### **ACT Playwriting Workshop**

The Art of Play (a.k.a. Drama for the Energetic) is a more advanced drama class for kids who have worked with theater basics before (maybe even taken Magic Carpet Riding). We will learn the art of improvisation and use it to play games, write monologues, scenes and get comfortable on stage.

#### Directing

This workshop will cover the basics of directing including use of space, working with text, working with actors, inventing a design and the rehearsal and production process.

The students will work alongside a professional director for the entire production process for one show, beginning with the first production meeting.

This workshop series focuses on working with a scene partner and developing a character through improvisation and scene work

#### **Advanced Acting/Scene Study**

Instructor: Colleen Rua Ages: 10-13 **Thursdays**, 6-7:30 PM, Nov 3rd-Dec10th.

Cost: \$100

Students will use text from famous plays to develop character, learn about intention and motivation and explore character history. They will work to develop a scene with a partner as well as a monologue for presentation.

#### Stage Management

Instructor: Colleen Rua Ages: 14-17

Four Monday evenings, 7 to 9 PM, Nov 7th-Dec 5th

Cost: \$100

Students will learn the basics of stage management, including organization of rehearsal schedule and materials, how to "call a show, and how to take staging notation. After taking this workshop, a student would be able to Assistant Stage Manage the summer production or Stage Manage a smaller show during the year.

This workshop will cover how to make simple props for an upcoming ACT production. These may be items that are specific to a time period or that can't be easily found elsewhere. It may be one big prop that everyone works on together or several small ones.

Students will learn the basics of simple set design including the layout of different types of stages, researching time period of a script, designing on a low budget with minimal elements and stage composition.

In this workshop, students will learn the basics of drawing a costume plot, researching costumes relevant to a specific production and putting together costumes from found pieces.


